Have You Made A Plan to Vote?

In-person absentee voting is open until 5PM on Nov. 2nd in every county across the state!

Visit your local Board of Elections or County Clerk's office during their normal business hours - generally 8AM - 5PM Monday through Friday. **[Click here to double check the address and hours and then head to the voting booth on Monday morning!](#)**

Qualified excuses include: being away on Election Day, being a caregiver to an incapacitated person, having contracted COVID or being in an at-risk category for contracting COVID, amongst others.

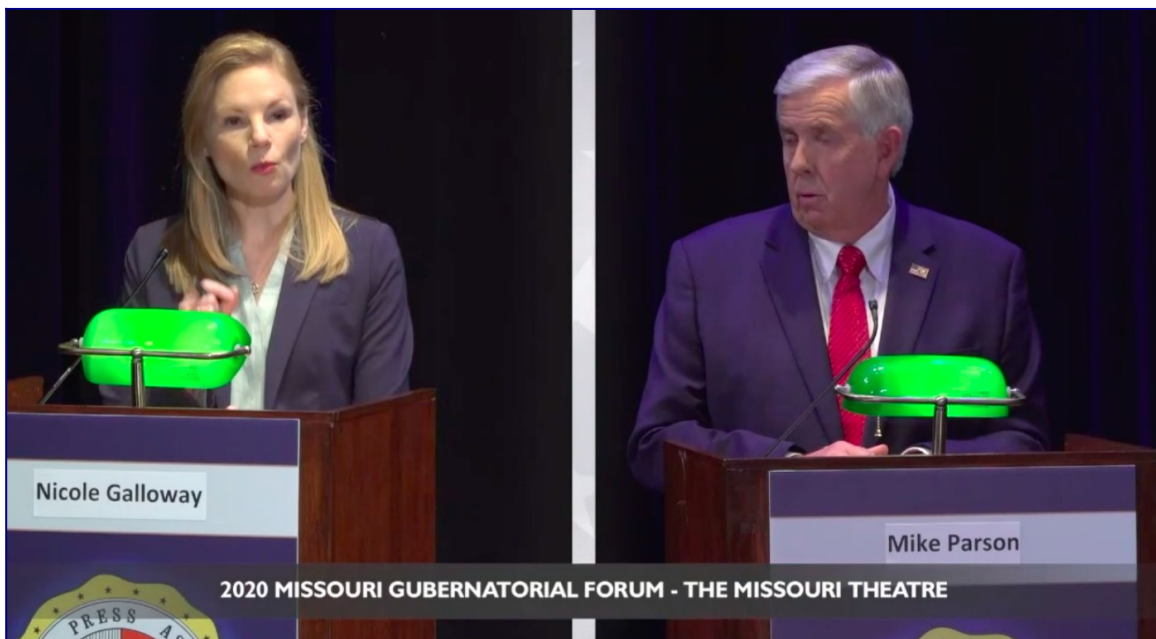
If you're voting by mail, remember to mark your ballot, read the instructions carefully, sign anything that needs to be signed, and return it ASAP.

If your plan is to vote on Election Day on Tuesday, November 3rd - know what time you'll go beforehand. There is tremendous interest in this election. If you can vote absentee in-person or by mail, go ahead and get it out of the way!
